Today, I had the pleasure of visiting Cessnock High School to chat with the amazing Interact students about what drew me to Rotary and how it's shaped my life. Spending time with these bright, passionate young leaders was a reminder of the power of service and community, and I wanted to share a bit about that experience with you all.

When I first joined Rotary, I wasn't exactly sure what to expect. Like many of you, I knew Rotary was about community service, but I didn't realize just how much it would offer me personally. I talked with the students today about a few key reasons I joined—and why I stay so committed. 1. Rotary Makes a Real Impact
