Richard knew a lot of the founding members in Cessnock Rotary Club as well as knowing many of the originals from Nelson Bay as he visited there to his holiday house.

Richard in reply mentioned the great support he had received from his wife Jenny over the whole period. When he had first joined Rotary there was an expectation to try for a makeup wherever possible. This custom has changed as have many things in the ways of Rotary. Richard commented on some of the marvellous nights he had attended with ambassadors, parliamentarians and VIPS. He thanked also his children and his brother John Turner OAM who had been part of his experience.
